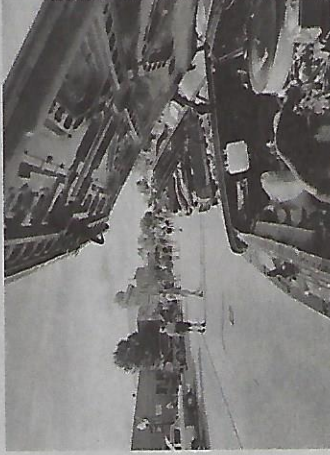

A flag presentation will take place at 6 p.m., followed by a performance from

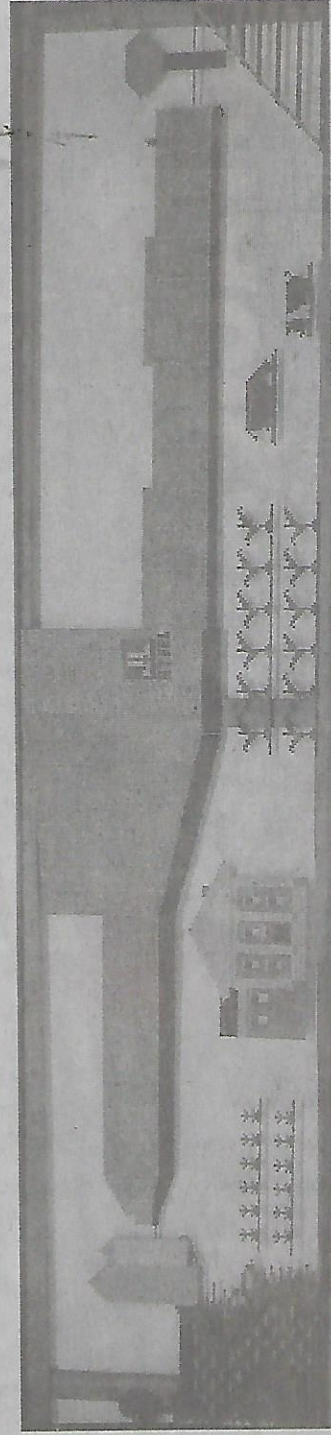
the Panteras at 6:30 p.m. There will be a street dance following the cruise night with Alike Arlynn Band performing.
